Cortland, NY.....Redding Reloading Equipment ever responsive to its customer base has added a new Stainless Steel pilot stop for 30 Cal. cases using a small flash hole like the Laupa 308 Palma Brass. These pilot stops are used in conjunction with Redding's unique small flash hole deburring tool (P/N 06110), which operates from the case mouth and is piloted to maintain precise alignment and repeatable cuts. Redding produces two models, one each for small and large flash holes. They each have an appropriately sized shaft to assist in differentiation.

Previously the small flash-hole tool, with its smaller diameter 9/64" shaft, had available pilots up to 6.5mm but the advent for specialized 30 cal cases using small primer pockets and flash holes (specifically Lapua 308 Palma brass) required the production of this new item. Redding continues to focus on the accuracy needs of serious handloaders by building the tools needed for constant improvement.

This new tool will also allow for the use of the previously mentioned small flash-hole 30 cal. brass on the small mandrel of the Redding Case Neck Gauge. Allowing for fast and easy sorting of the brass for case, neck wall uniformity.
